## Introduction

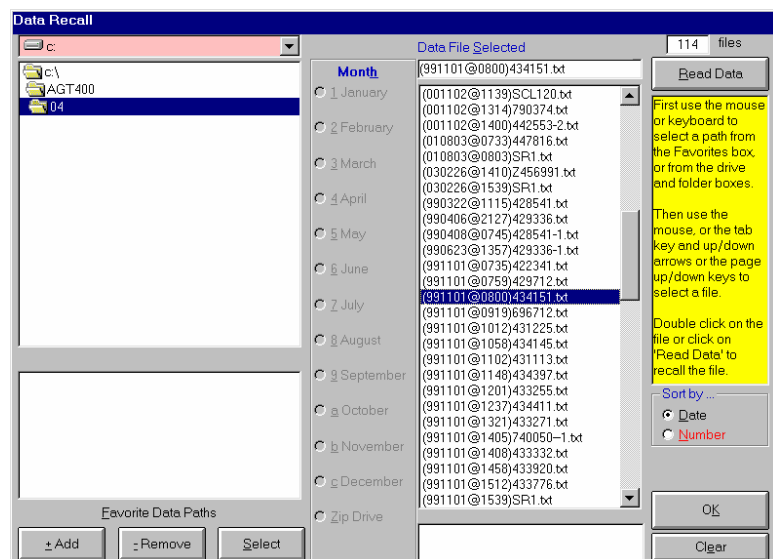

**GR200  
Is A  
Dying Breed**

Some gauge users are still operating with the old Gamma Instruments GR200 systems. These units were developed in 1989 and are virtually obsolete.

The 4810E and 2005 Xycom workstations used as GR200 video monitors from '89 through '00 are no longer manufactured or even serviced by the original manufacturer. In addition, both the CPU-186 and ASP4 circuit boards are totally obsolete and the few remaining pieces sell at exorbitant prices.

In many cases, we can upgrade the old GR200 gauges for less than half the cost of a new AGT400, and provide you with most or all of our advanced features. Do yourself a favor and budget to upgrade your GR200 gauge before you end up without a working gauge due to the failure of an obsolete component.
