Beat the Boss Challenge

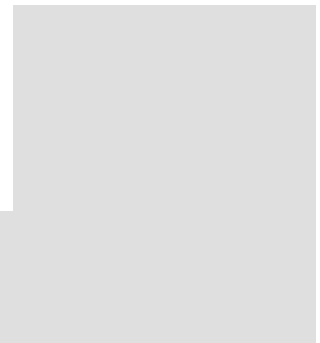
